How 2+2 Works

- The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Biology at WIU. Students
 will fill out applications for both schools, consult the advisors and catalogs from both schools for specifics.
 This completion guide is designed to ensure graduation in four years by taking courses at both
 Southeastern Community College (SCC) and WIU. This guide assumes students have met all course
 prerequisites required by SCC and admission requirements for WIU.
- Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at SCC, students will receive an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree. Students will be required to complete the Biology core requirements at WIU, and upon completion of the final two years' curriculum requirements students will receive the B.S. degree with a major in Biology at WIU. In general, a minimum of 60 semester hours (s.h.) will be taken at SCC at SCC rates and 60 s.h. from WIU at WIU rates.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 should be achieved by the junior year. These grade point averages must be maintained for graduation as an Biology major.

Notes for WIU:

- The <u>Biology major has the following options in the major</u>: Botany, Environmental Biology, Medical Sciences, Microbiology and Zoology. Specific Courses will depend on the option pursued.
- This requirement may be waived with 3 years of High School Foreign Language (all one language) with a C grade or higher. High School credit can be provided by sending an official high school transcript to the WIU Registrar's Office to have this requirement waived.
- Note⁸ Medical Science Option- Please add Math 129,133 and BIOL 170 to the above plan.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 will be required overall, in the major and in the minor(s) (if applicable)
