



B.A. Degree with a Major in History

Buena Vista University's Online & Site Programs offers degree completion programs for those students that have at least 60 credit hours from the community college. We facilitate the smooth transfer of credits from Southeastern Community College. This advising guide is effective for students entering BVU in the 2019-20 academic years. As course and degree requirements change, students are encouraged to consult with BVU advisors located on campus in Room 211.

Southeastern Community College has a full articulation with Buena Vista University. Students who have completed an approved associate's degree at SCC can seamlessly move on to complete a bachelor's degree through Buena Vista University.
