See rules changes in #2 & #3 below. Let's be in by 5:15 pm!

1. **Each** golfer hits a tee shot unless participating in an event-sponsored challenge.
2. Play proceeds from the location where the **best shot** landed. Each team member hits the next shot from the same location. Teams continue playing, using the best shot.
TWO-PUTT MAXIMUM PER HOLE PER TEAM!
3. Only **one score per hole** is recorded for the team, representing the number of "best shots" used. **DOUBLE BOGEY IS MAX SCORE PER HOLE!**
4. **Flight Prizes** will be awarded on the 1st, 2nd & 3rd lowest scores per team in three flights. Ties will be broken by comparing scores from the 9th hole, proceeding backward until determined.
