School Bus Driver

Course Description

School bus drivers must have a commercial driver's license if they drive a vehicle designed to transport (seat) 16 or more persons, including the driver. School bus drivers must have a school bus endorsement in addition to a passenger endorsement on their commercial driver's license (CDL). To get the school bus endorsement, you must pass a knowledge test on sections 2, 4 and 10 of the manual. (If your school bus has air brakes, you must also pass a knowledge test on Section 5.) You must also pass the skills test required for the class of school bus you drive or intend to drive. The sections do NOT provide information on all the federal and state requirements needed before you drive a school bus. You should be thoroughly familiar with all specific school bus procedures, laws and regulations in your state and local school district.

New Bus Drivers

Need to complete a New Driver Online Class followed by a Stop 3 New Driver class within 6 months of driving a school bus.

Continuing Education

Every year to continue driving a School Bus a Stop 3 Refresher class must be completed.

This must be complied with to drive a School Bus in the State of Iowa.
