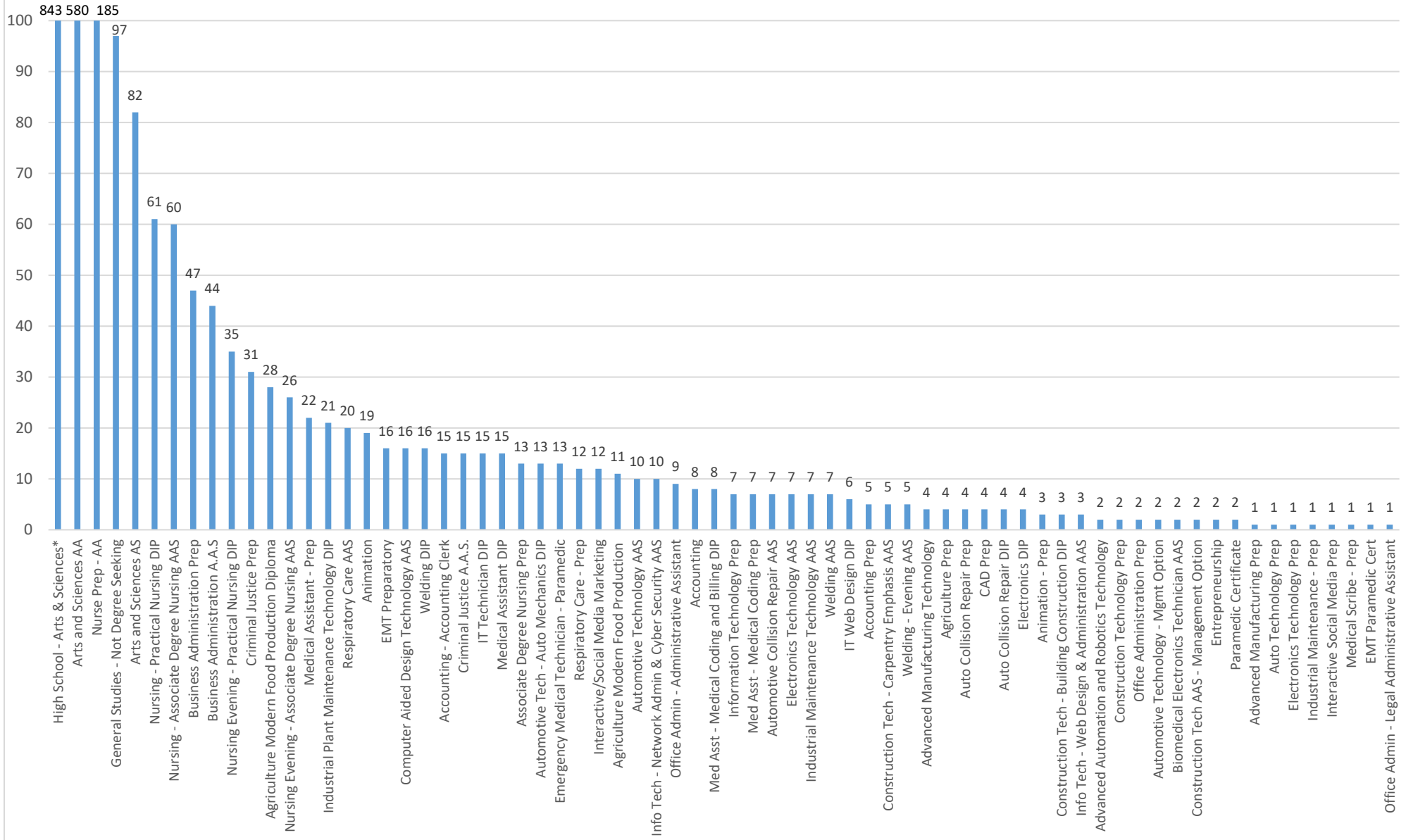

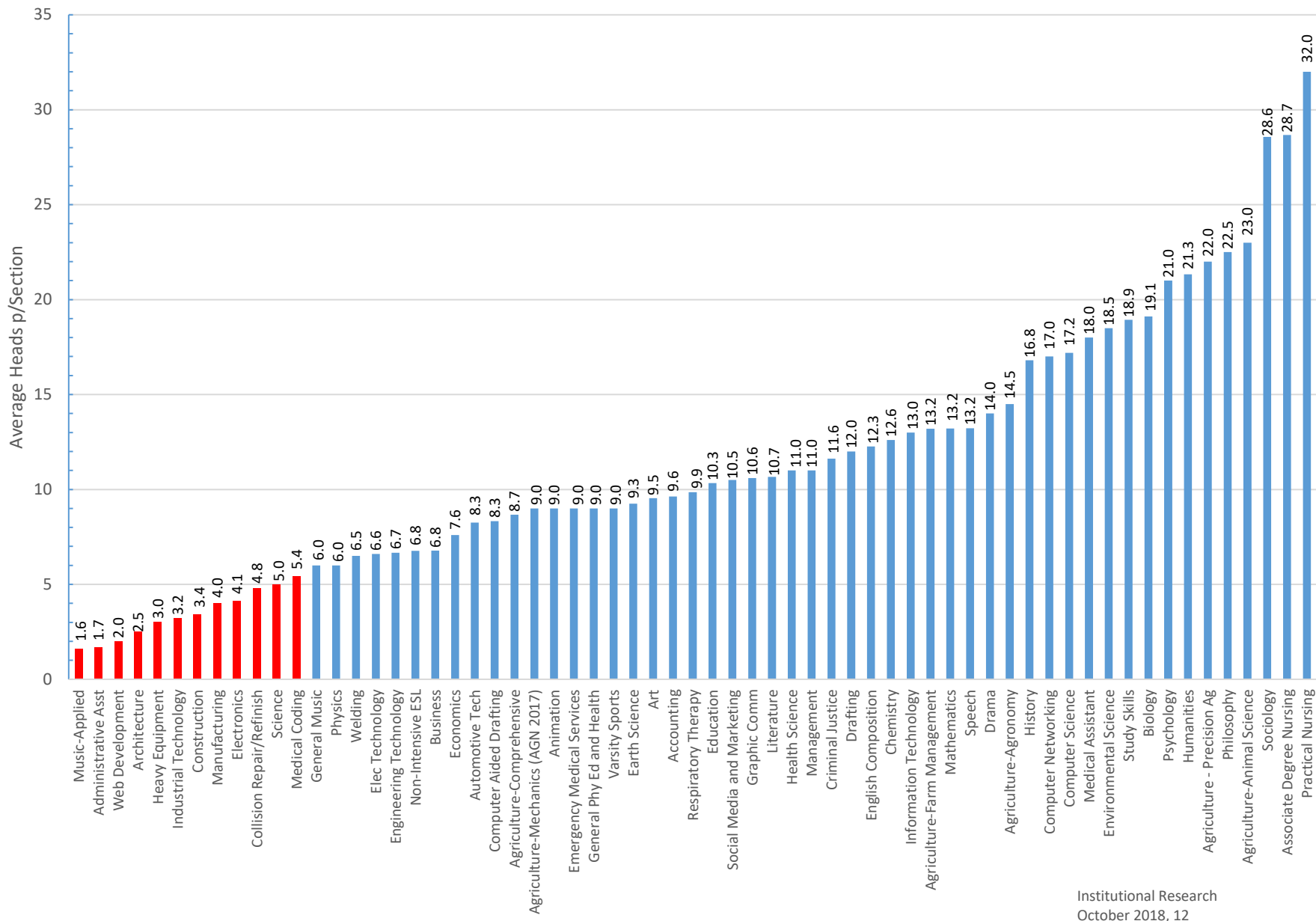

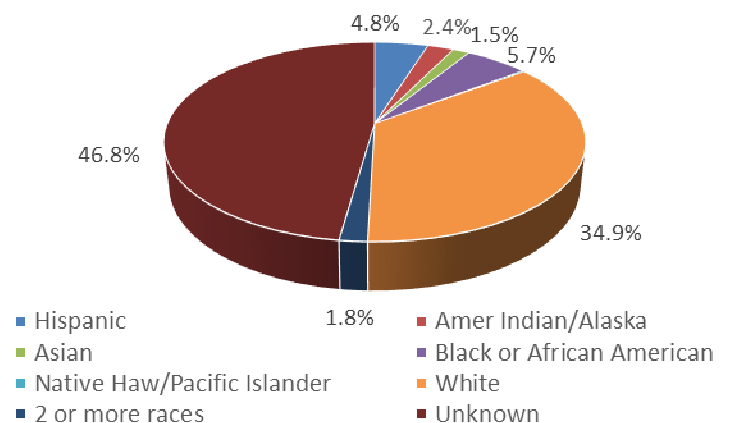

Fall 2018 Gender Percentages

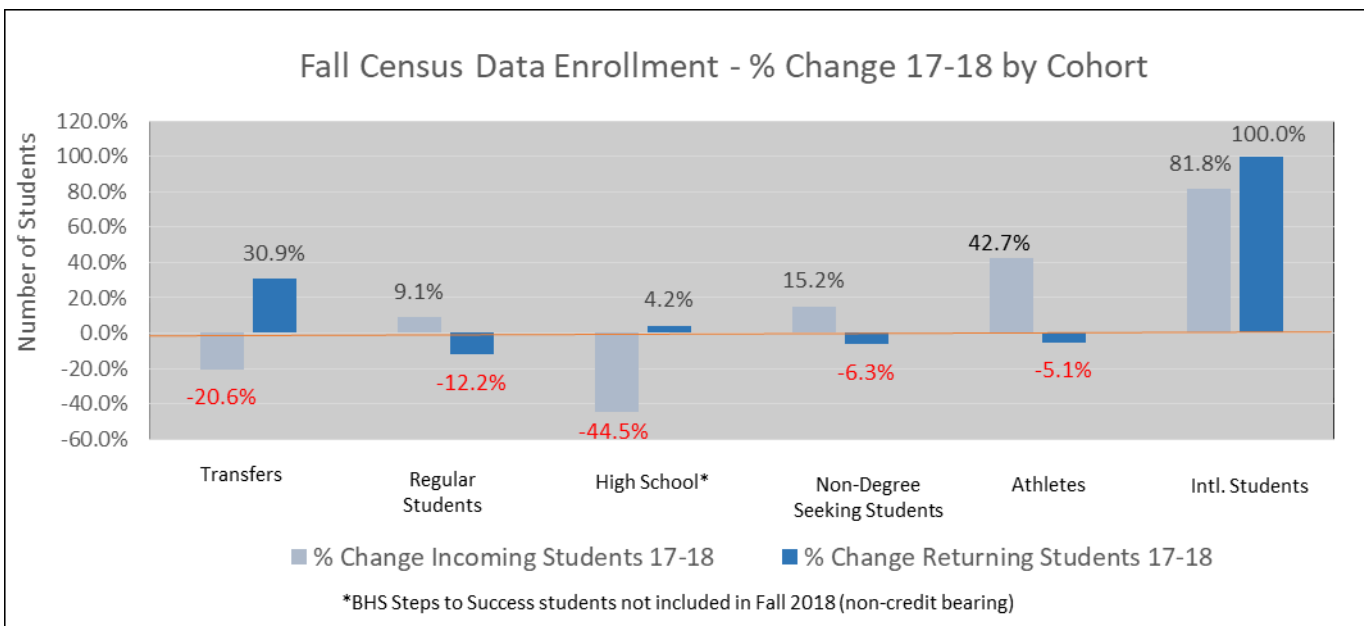


Fall 2018 Ethnicity Percentages
