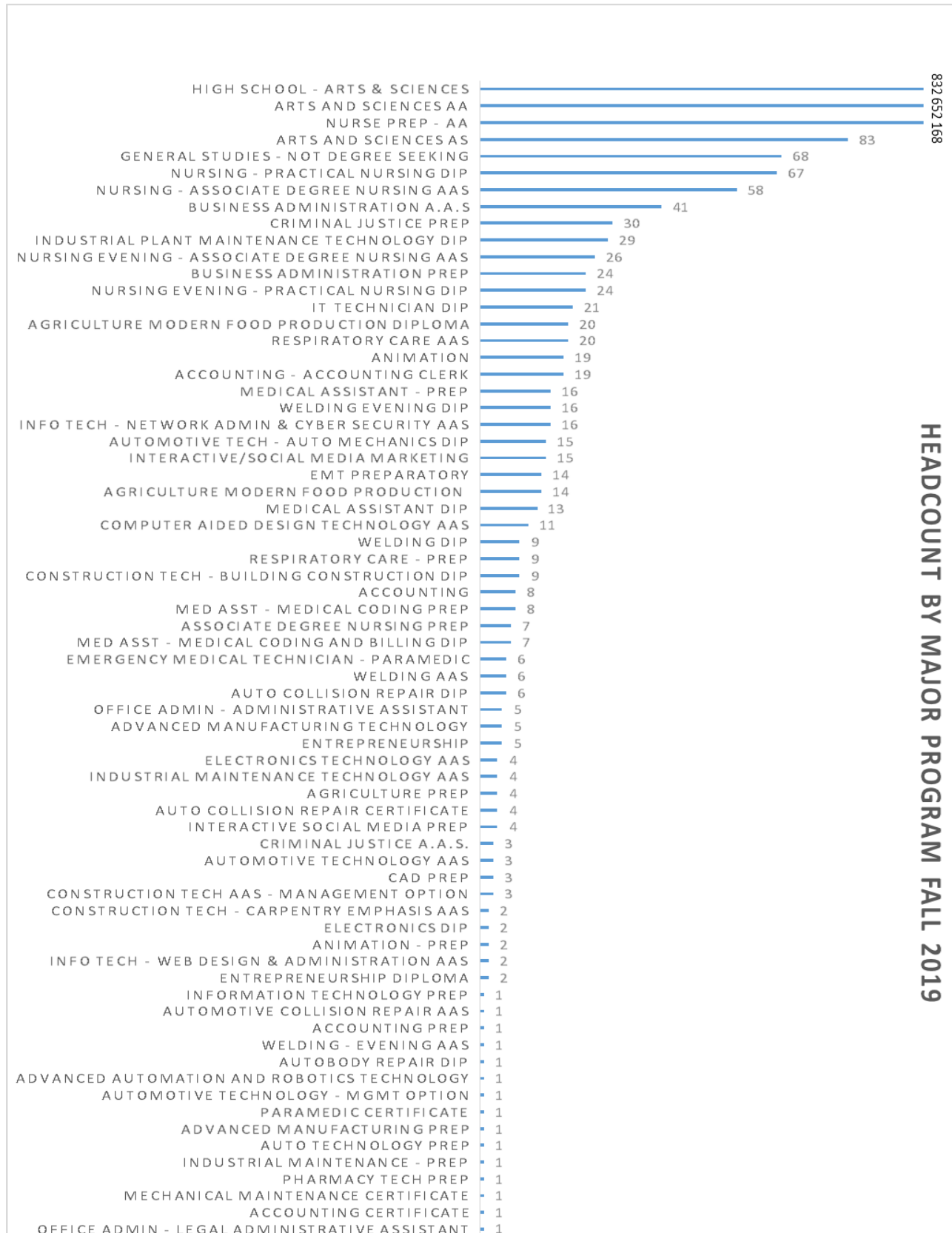

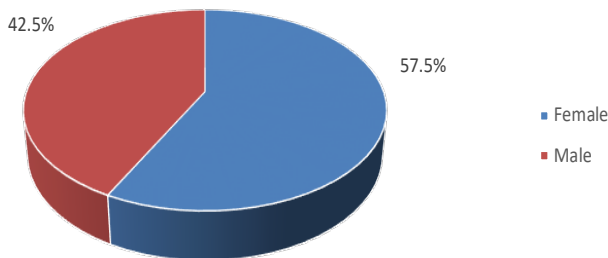

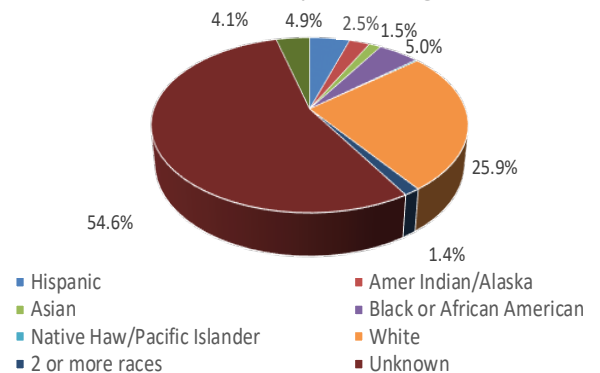

Fall 2019 Gender Percentages



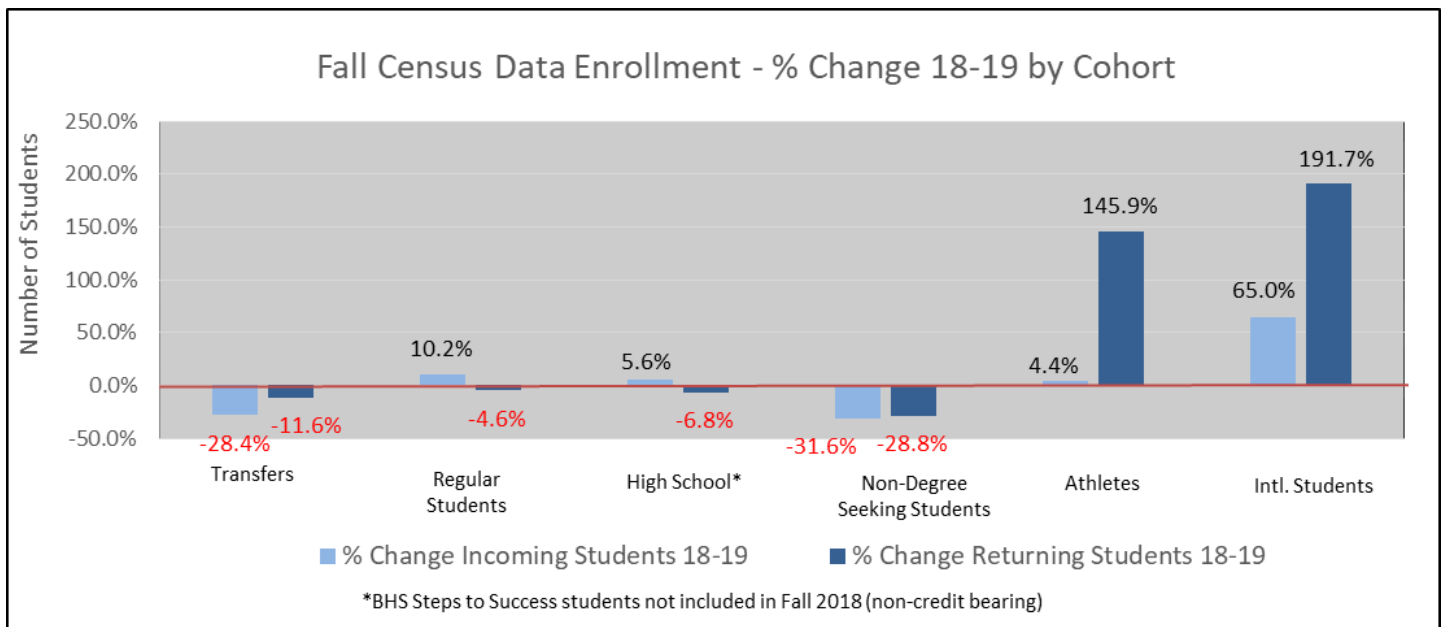
Fall 2019 Ethnicity Percentages
